EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. Federal government leadership center seeks new executive director. Established in 1989, the Center seeks a candidate with vibrant ideas and the ability to create and implement a robust strategy that will take the Center into the future, raising the visibility of the Center and the reach of its programs. A key quality for the new executive director is the ability to engage Congress and the public on the value of public service and working for the government. The executive director should be someone who has or can work with a governing board, while at the same time acting as a member of and advisor to the board on direction and management of the Center.
