



Bio – Kathy Roth-Douquet

Kathy is a founder and the CEO of Blue Star Families, the nation's largest chapter nonprofit serving military families reaching over 1.5 million members of military families annually; a public speaker and frequent commentator on public affairs; and a practicing attorney. She also co-directs the Summit Institute, the nonprofit associated with Summit and Powder Mountain, Utah. Kathy previously served as a political appointee in the White House and Department of Defense, and was awarded the Secretary of Defense Medal for Outstanding Public Service and the Chief of Staff of the Army medal for Outstanding Civilian Service to the Army.



The author of two critically recognized books on public affairs, Kathy has appeared on the Today Show, Fox and Friends, CNN, and NPR; was a regular contributor for USA Today; and is a frequent speaker at universities and conferences. She has served as an advisor to billionaires, royalty, and U.S. elected officials. She is a member of the Council on Foreign Relations, serves on a number of civic boards and has received a number of civic awards including President George H.W. Bush's Daily Point of Light Award.
